MATH – We continue to focus on **MEMORIZING** multiplication tables to 12. Students should be reciting (practicing) them daily. I encourage you to help your child **memorize** their times tables to 10 (or 12 for a challenge). Have your child recite one or two times tables **DAILY** (in the car on the way to school, before bed, etc.). Repetition is important for many students. We are working on fact fluency.

WRITING – We have been working on narrative structure and writing a narrative. We will be choosing one story to type up, revise and edit. Students usually don't like the revision process, but it is where apply the language skills we have been working on in class.

VALENTINES DAY – A class list of student names will be sent home. Just a reminder that valentines cards should be made out to the whole class. It is Red, White & Pink Day, this is a non-uniform day.
