Letter from the Superintendent

Dear Parents,

Cannabis legalization took place in Canada on October 17, 2018. In BC, marijuana is still illegal for anyone under 19 to purchase, sell or consume, and remains a controlled substance, like alcohol. The legalization of cannabis will see very little change for our Catholic Schools in the Diocese of Prince George (CISPG). School Codes of Conduct and CISPG existing policies are already in place which prohibit intoxication, impairment, smoking, vaping, or drinking on school property for individuals of any age. Please see attached policies.

The Cannabis Control and Licensing Act creates serious criminal penalties for those who sell or provide cannabis to youth. The act also establishes new offences and strict penalties for those who use youth to commit a cannabis offence.

If you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to contact the school principal.
