
Religion-This month we will learn more about some of our saints. We celebrate All Saints Day and All Souls Day the first two days of November. We will also learn more about the significance of Remembrance Day and participate in our school ceremony on November 10th.

Math- We will continue with addition with regrouping in the tens and hundreds place up to 1000. We will then learn subtraction with regrouping in the ones, tens and hundreds place up to 1000.

Science – As we continue our study of biodiversity we will look at food chains and food webs. We will identify the producers, consumers and decomposers in food chains. With this knowledge, students will complete a diorama of a chosen ecosystem and identify these different components in their ecosystems. Students will complete their diorama at home but will work on the written part of this project at school.

Socials- We will compare our own worldview with the Indigenous Peoples' worldview. Student will create a culture wheel where they will explore their cultural traditions and worldviews. We will learn how the land and its resources in plants and animals shape the lives of

Indigenous Peoples.
