Dear Parents:

Our extra-curricular volleyball program begins next (the week of September 24th). This year we will have a boys' team consisting of all interested Grade 6 and 7 boys and a girls' team consisting of all interested Grade 6 and 7 girls. The girls will practice Tuesdays from 3:00 until 4:15pm and the boys will practice on Wednesdays from 3:00 to 4:15pm. An optional skills practice will take place Mondays at lunch recess. A couple of practices will take place on Thursdays if there is a game on Wednesday.

Mrs. Barth and Cassidy Malgunas (a former student at the school) will be coaching the boys and I will be coaching the girls.

The game schedule is included with this letter. The season will finish up with the Knights of Columbus Volleyball tournament in November (the dates are not completely set yet). A schedule will be sent home shortly and will also be posted on the website: www.icschool.ca

As long as the students are completing homework, maintaining their grades, and behaving well, they will be welcome on the team. This will be up to the homeroom teacher's discretion. This slip must be returned on or before September 25th.

Team players will be provided with a school jersey and shorts at the beginning of the season. These are to be returned to the school no later than November 23rd. A fee of \$50.00 will be charged for non-return of this uniform. Students must have their full uniform to play in any game. Any undershirts must be white (or from their gym strip).

Our hope is to have parents drive students to away games. Please let us know if you can help with transportation by marking it on the permission slip below. We will confirm with you before the games if you are actually needed to drive on the day.
