
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Welcome Back!

Our school is currently in the process of the careful implementation of Phase Three of BC's Restart Plan, Stage 2 of the Education Plan as mandated by the Minister of Education. In accordance with the K-12 Education Restart Plan, and the revised public health guidelines, all students will be returning to full in-class instruction, on September 10, 2020. This will be a full day of instruction for all grades. The exception will be Kindergarten, as we will be implementing a gradual entrance for students.

Parking Lot Safety and Regulations

Please DRIVE SLOWLY, even if you are late!! STOPPING AT THE TOP OF THE HILL OR CROSS WALK is not permitted for pick up OR drop off. Students and parents MUST use the pedestrian crosswalk to cross the parking lot.

AM Drop Off – The row of parking stalls in front of the church are reserved for parishioners **ONLY**!

PM Pick Up – Parents are required to exit vehicle and pick up students in the designated pedestrian area in front of the school.

ABSENCES

Please contact the **school office AND the classroom teacher** before 8:25 AM, **preferably by EMAIL** if your child is ill, will be absent from school or will be arriving late.

If the school is not contacted, the school administrative assistant will contact parents.

Students <u>must</u> have an explanatory note for any absence from school, email is sufficient and preferred. Notes must be submitted to <u>classroom teachers</u>.

LATES

Co-operation of parents in punctual arrival of students is appreciated. Students are expected to be here **before the first bell at 8:25 AM**. If students come in late, **they must report to the office for a late**

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slip. Parents will be contacted regarding repeated lates. Thank you for ensuring our school day starts off on time and with no disruption to classes.
